DLI Target 2.3: At least 75% of GPS have a Student Teacher Ratio of 40:1 or less

Teacher recruitment and deployment are the sub-components of component one stated as 'Quality' of PEDP4 (1st Revised). The objective of sub-component 1.3 is to ensure that teachers are recruited in the required number and rationally deployed. To address and evaluate the accomplishment of the above sub-components, Disbursement Linked Indicator (DLI) target 2.3 (At least 75% of GPS have a Student Teacher Ratio of 40:1 or less) is fixed up as one of the indicators.

DLI Target 2.3:

At least 75% of GPS have a Student Teacher Ratio of 40:1 or less

Definition of DLI 2.3:

Student Teacher Ratio (STR) measures the number of enrolled students per teacher. It is calculated the number of enrolled students in pre-primary to grade 5 divided by the number of deployed teachers (not positions).

Achievement Description:

This target is considered achieved when the STR of 40 or less students per teacher has been achieved in at least 75% of schools as reported in the ASPR/APSC reports of Year 4.
